## Supreme Split¬retūrn cruise ROUTE K200

FROM SPLIT TO BOL, JELSA, KORČULA, DUBROVNIK, MLJET, HVAR AND RETURN TO SPLIT

#### Day 1 SPLIT ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split's airport or your Split hotel to harbour, where embarkation begins at 13:00h. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome Reception followed by dinner this evening.

#### Day 2 SPLIT - BOL - JELSA, Sunday (B, L)

Morning sail towards Bol on Brač Island, you will discover one of the most beautiful beaches in the entire Mediterranean - "Zlatni Rat" (the Golden Horn), which is constantly changing direction due to the ocean currents with optional swim if weather permits. Return to the ship for lunch and set sail for Jelsa on the island of Hvar. One of the most picturesque towns on the island of Hvar; Jelsa is nestled in amongst hills dense with pine woods. The town quay extends all the way around the harbour with numerous laid moorings. Walk around the town to see old stone streets, squares, churches, and parks. Enjoy a coffee in the main square and soak up the Mediterranean atmosphere of this bustling town. Your evening is free to explore Jelsa on your own.

#### Day 3 JELSA - KORČULA (Wine tasting), Monday (B, L, T)

Early in the morning we set sail for the island of Korčula, with swimming stop. if weather permits, in one of pristine bays, time to relax and lunch on board. Continue towards Korčula, the most preserved medieval town, thought to be the birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. Take a walking tour of Korčula which takes you through its narrow, cobbled streets full of history and enjoy wine tasting in one of the local wine bars. Evening is free to explore the town on your own.

#### Day 4 KORČULA – DUBROVNIK, Tuesday (B, L)

In the morning sail to Dubrovnik, the "Pearl of the Adriatic", a UNESCO World Heritage site. Upon arrival in Dubrovnik, you will enjoy a guided tour of the magnificent Old Town with a panoramic bus ride above the Old Town. After the panoramic view, we will arrive at the historical centre of Dubrovnik, walk through STRADUN - both a street and a square, the most famous place inside the town walls, the famous city enlisted as UNESCO's World Heritage site, where your guide will show you the most interesting sights of Dubrovnik. After city tour, you will be left on your own to explore the city, visit City Walls, the Franciscan Monastery with Europe's second oldest pharmacy, the Rector's Palace, and the Cathedral, take a boat ride to Lokrum island or take the cable car to the top of the Mount Srđ. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

#### Day 5 DUBROVNIK - MLJET, Wednesday (B, L, CD)

In the morning head further north to the Island of Mljet. Mljet National Park encompasses five types of forest, many species of birds, and two deep lakes, Veliko Jezero (Big Lake) and Malo Jezero (Small Lake). Join the Cruise Manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park. Alternatively, you can rent bicycles, scooters, or kayaks to explore the National Park or island on your own. Tonight, enjoy Captain's dinner on board.

#### Day 6 MLJET - HVAR, Thursday (B, L)

Take a break for a swim during your morning cruise. Continue sailing through lunch, arriving this afternoon in Hvar, a favourite holiday destination for international celebrities, but it's also a charming seaside town with 8 centuries of architecture. On a walking tour visit the old town with the picturesque little streets and the first public theatre in Europe (older than Shakespeare's theatre in the UK), the Franciscan Monastery and much more. Your evening is free in Hvar. You can explore more and dine on your own at one of the many restaurants in town.

#### Day 7 HVAR - SPLIT, Friday (B, L)

Next, we head to our final port Split with a stop along the way to swim, cool off and relax, if weather permits, with lunch on board. In the late afternoon we arrive in Split to take a walking tour of the historic inner city takes us to the Palace of the Roman Emperor Diocletian, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We see the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, its Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter's Temple, the Peristyle, and the Cathedral. Your evening is free in Split.



#### Day 8 SPLIT DEPARTURE, Saturday (B)

After breakfast it is time to disembark. You will be transferred to Split airport or your Split hotel.



FROM SPLIT TO NP KRKA, ŠIBENIK, ZADAR, NP KORNATI, PRIMOŠTEN, BOL, STARI GRAD, HVAR, VIS, BIŠEVO AND RETURN TO SPLIT

#### Day 1 SPLIT ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split's airport or your Split hotel to harbour, where embarkation begins at 13:00h. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome reception followed by dinner this evening.

#### Day 2 SPLIT – NP KRKA – ŠIBENIK, Sunday (B, L)

Depart from Split early in the morning towards Šibenik. After lunch disembark in Šibenik and take the bus to visit Krka National Park. It's magnificent waterfalls, including the famous waterfall Skradinski Buk, are one of Croatia's most famous sights. After the sightseeing tour, we will return to Šibenik, a city of exceptional history and rich cultural heritage. Set out on a walking tour of Šibenik historical center and visit one of the most beautiful Renaissance Cathedrals of the Adriatic. Your night is at leisure in town.

#### Day 3 ŠIBENIK – GALEŠNJAK – ZADAR, Monday (B, L)

Leaving Šibenik early in the morning we set sail for Galešnjak, a typical small Dalmatian island, where you can enjoy a swim stop in one of secluded bays. Enjoy lunch while we cruise into Zadar harbour in the afternoon. Set out on a walking tour of Zadar historical center and admire the old walls and Port Gate built in 16th century. Visit the Square of the Five Wells, the Church of St. Donat, the Roman Forum and the largest Cathedral in Dalmatia, St. Anastasia. If there is a breeze, enjoy at the sea organ, an amazing art installation. Overnight in Zadar.

#### Day 4 ZADAR – PRIMOŠTEN, Tuesday (B, L)

Morning departure for Primošten, sailing through the Kornati National Park, which consists of 89 unforgettable islands, islets, and rocks. Kornati National Park is often called a "nautical paradise" and is a rich marine ecosystem. Enjoy swimming in one of the hidden coves. Afterwards we continue to Primošten built on a hill and dominated by the parish Church of St. George which was built in 1485. Your evening is at leisure in town.

#### Day 5 PRIMOŠTEN – STARI GRAD, Wednesday (B, L,)

In the morning we will continue towards the town of Stari Grad on the island of Hvar we will sail pass by the most famous beach in Dalmatia – Golden Horn ("Zlatni rat") near Bol – whose pebbles shifts from side to side as the wind and waves constantly change in shape. As the weather conditions can sometimes be very unpredictable or there can be crowds during the high season, you will be informed in time if a swim stop near Golden Horn ("Zlatni rat") is possible. We head off to Hvar Island where we'll visit Stari Grad. Stari Grad is one of the oldest towns in Europe with many friendly and affordable konobas and restaurants in the backstreets of the old town. The Stari Grad Plain and the old town centre of Stari Grad have been listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites since 2008. Your evening is free to explore Stari Grad on your own.

#### Day 6 STARI GRAD - HVAR - VIS (Wine tasting), Thursday (B, L, T, CD)

Our morning cruise starts with Hvar Town. Hvar is a favourite holiday destination for international celebrities, but it's also a charming seaside town with 8 centuries of architecture. On a walking tour visit the old town with the picturesque little streets and the first public theatre in Europe. We will continue towards the island of Vis once a strategic naval Yugoslav base and closed to the public. Due to this isolation, Vis has a special charm – "the Mediterranean as it once was" making it interesting to visit. Upon arrival in town of Vis join the walking tour to visit the remains of the Roman thermal place and views of the beautiful Villae Rusticae situated along the waterfront and enjoy wine tasting in one of the local wine bars. Tonight, enjoy Captain's dinner on board.

#### Day 7 VIS - BIŠEVO - SPLIT, Friday (B, L)

We will have an early morning cruise towards small island of Biševo to visit the Blue cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon. As sometimes weather conditions can be very unpredictable, the possibility of our visit will depend on those conditions, however you will be notified of this on time. We arrive in Split in the afternoon. This UNESCO World Heritage city bases the city centre in and around the stunning Diocletian's Palace, the Roman emperor Diocletian's retirement palace from 295–305 AD. Stroll through the palace basement filled with market stalls and outside experience the historical architecture of this beautiful palace. See the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, it's Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter's temple, the Peristyle and many other unique sites. Overnight in Split.

#### Day 8 SPLIT DEPARTURE, Saturday (B)

Disembark after breakfast. You will be transferred to Split airport/hotel.

#### Day 1 SPLIT ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split airport or your Split hotel to harbor, where embarkation begins at 15:00h. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome reception followed by dinner this evening.

#### Day 2 SPLIT – ŠIBENIK, Sunday (B, L)

In the morning join a guided tour of Split, visit the seafront promenade and Roman Emperor Diocletian's Palace. The historical center of the city is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Set sail to Šibenik and set out on a walking tour of Šibenik historical center and visit one of the most beautiful Renaissance Cathedrals of the Adriatic. Your night is at leisure in town.

#### Day 3 ŠIBENIK - NP KRKA - VODICE - ZADAR, Monday (B, L)

We start the day with breakfast, followed by a bus visit to the Krka National Park. It's magnificent waterfalls, including the famous waterfall Skradinski Buk, are one of Croatia's most famous sights. After the sightseeing tour, we continue sailing towards Zadar, swimming stop and lunch on board. Set out on a walking tour of Zadar historical center and admire the old walls and Port Gate built in 16th century. Visit the Square of the Five Wells, the Church of St. Donat, the Roman Forum and the largest Cathedral in Dalmatia, St. Anastasia. If there is a breeze, enjoy at the sea organ, an amazing art installation. Overnight in Zadar.

#### Day 4 ZADAR - RAB, Tuesday (B, L)

Departure towards Rab, known as the "Island of Love", with an old town of the same name, with swimming stop. Guided city tour including the medieval walls and the famous four bell towers (you can climb one of them) along with palaces, churches, and squares where many artists paint and exhibit their works. Legend has it that the local nuns created a special Rab cake for the pope who visited Rab. We stop for a tasting of traditional Rab cake. You can see how is made, learn about it, taste it, you can even go to a workshop and try to make it by yourself. The recipe for the Rab cake remains a secret kept only by the islanders. Overnight in the town of Rab.

#### Day 5 RAB – MALI LOŠINJ, Wednesday (B, L)

Early this morning we set sail for the beautiful and untouched island of Lošinj, known as the "Island of Wellness and Vitality" and the "Island of the Sun". It is also known for its lush green vegetation, pine trees, wildflowers, and herbs. After stopping for a swim in the crystal-clear Adriatic, we arrive in the town of Mali Lošinj, which boasts one of the most beautiful harbors on the Adriatic. Upon arrival, take a walk along the beautiful waterfront where there are nice shops, restaurants, and attractive cafes. The main tourist attraction is the Museum of Apoxyomenos. It is dedicated to the ancient bronze statue of Apoxyomenos, which was found in 1999 on the seabed near the islet of Vela Orjula at a depth





of 45 meters. If you are interested in art, be sure to visit on your own the Fritzi Palace - Lošinj Museum, which houses a rich collection of works by Croatian and European artists. Overnight in Mali Lošinj.

#### Day 6 MALI LOŠINJ – SALI, Thursday (B, L, CD)

Departure after breakfast and a stop to swim in one of the quiet bays. Enjoy the incredibly clean sea. After lunch, sailing along the Kornati National Park to the small fishing village of Sali, a tourist town on Dugi Otok (Long Island) with a thousand-year-old history of fishing and the nearest town to the "Telašćica" Nature Park. It is mentioned in the 12th century, having received its name from its salt works, and today it is a favourite destination for divers. Sali is a place of a thousand-year-old fishing tradition, which was confirmed by written documents from the 10th century. Tonight, aboard our ship, enjoy the Captain's dinner.

#### Day 7 SALI – HVAR, Friday (B, L)

Take a swim break during the morning cruise. Continue sailing during the lunch, arriving in the afternoon in Hvar, a favourite vacation destination of world celebrities, but also a charming seaside town with 8-century-old architecture. You can walk through the old town with picturesque alleys and see the first public theatre in Europe (older than Shakespeare's theatre in Great Britain), the Franciscan monastery and much more and dine on your own at one of the many restaurants in town. The evening in Hvar is free.

#### Day 8 HVAR - SPLIT DEPARTURE, Saturday (B)

Early morning departure for Split. After a tasty breakfast, it's time to say goodbye to captain, crew and all your new friends as this cruise-of-a-lifetime comes to an end. Shared transfer is provided to Split Airport or your Split Hotel.

#### **REFUNDS FOR UNUSED SERVICES**

No refunds will be made for unused services (like transfer services) or unused part of the program included in tour price once travel arrangements have commenced, especially in the cases where passengers are unable to travel due to invalid travel documents (passports. visas). In case that client cannot find the arrival transfer/driver at the airports, they have to call emergency contact number in the travel documents.

#### COMPLAINTS

Any complaints regarding service have to be given directly to the KOMPAS representative (Tour Escort) on the spot. Any complaints regarding service on board have to be given directly on the ship to KOMPAS representative (Cruise Manager). Complaints have to be sent to KOMPAS within 15 days from the customer's departure. Otherwise, such complaints will not be taken into consideration.

#### **TOUR MEMBERSHIP**

In order to ensure congenial membership, Kompas reserves the right to accept or reject any person as a tour participant and to expel from the tour any participant whose conduct is deemed incompatible with the interests of the tour group.

#### INSURANCE

Kompas strongly recommends insurance to cover cancellation charges, trip interruption, accidents and baggage loss. Kompas accepts no responsibility for damage or loss of baggage or other personal property.

#### **DELAYED ARRIVAL**

We do not cover any refunds for missed /late flights and, subsequently, late arrival/no start of the tour. All additional costs have to be settled on the spot by passengers. We recommend that in case of delay clients call the emergency phone number which is in the travel documents.

#### **PROGRAM PRICES**

Program prices are per person, based on two persons sharing a room. Single room supplements and triple room reductions are listed where applicable. When applies, transfers are provided complimentary only from airports to hotel and vice versa by motor coach or private vehicle, only on the first and the last day of the tour, as per the itinerary, under the condition that accurate transfer information is provided. Pre-stay and post-stay transfers are not included in the tour rate, but can be arranged on request.

#### ACCOMMODATIONS

The hotels classified in KOMPAS brochure are based on local classifications, which vary from country to country. Hotels listed in this brochure will be used on almost all departures. If changes become necessary for any reason, booked accommodation can be substituted only by an accommodation unit of the same or higher category and at the price confirmed during booking. While every effort is made to reserve twin bedded rooms, it may happen that a hotel provides some double bedded rooms instead. If such thing happens, double bedded rooms will try to be allocated to couples. Triple share rooms are generally based on an extra rollaway bed, which is not always suitable for adults. Please note that standard policy is that hotel rooms are available for check-in after 14:00. Early check-in needs to be advised in advance and may require a pre-night to be booked and paid for. Because of the limited number of different cabins, we are not in a possibility to confirm or guarantee a specific type of bed, but we try to allocate guests according to their wishes. So if you demand a specific type of bed, we kindly ask you to note that to us while making a reservation, and we will try to fulfill your wishes.

#### LOCAL HOLIDAYS

During national holidays certain facilities (museums, restaurants, sightseeing tours and shopping) may be limited or unavailable. Alternatives will be offered whenever possible.

#### LUGGAGE

In case of land tours, porterage is not included in program price. No responsibility is accepted for loss or damage to baggage, travel documents or passenger's belongings, nor for luggage loss that occurred in the hotels or luggage left in the bus depots during night periods. Kompas will not accept responsibility for baggage damage caused by normal wear and tear in handling and transportation. All lost luggage on connecting flights are not responsibility of Kompas. We do not guarantee that the luggage will be found and delivered to assigned hotel. We will provide assistance on the spot (through our tour director and local offices) that will help the passenger communicate with airline company.

#### SHARED TRANSFER ANNOUNCEMENT

If clients need a shared transfer with Kompas, it is necessary to provide information such as the client's contact number (full international phone number - cell phone/mobile phone) just in case we need to contact them on the spot, flight details (date and time of arrival/departure, flight number) or accommodation information if they are staying in a private accommodation or a hotel (full name and address) no later than 10 days before the departure date.

#### PASSPORTS AND VISAS

A valid passport is required for all tour participants. All passengers, regardless of the passport they hold, should check with the appropriate consulates to determine if any visas are needed. Securing any needed visas is the responsibility of the tour participant.

#### TRAVELERS WHO NEED SPECIAL ASSISTANCE

Any disability requiring special attention must be reported to Kompas at the time of booking. Kompas will make reasonable efforts to accommodate the special needs of disabled tour participants, but is not responsible for any denial of services by carriers, hotels, lodges, restaurants, or other independent suppliers, nor any additional expenses incurred. Motor coaches and minibuses are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. We regret we cannot provide individual assistance to a tour member for walking, dining, getting on/ off motor coaches and other transportation vehicles, or other personal needs. Travelers who need assistance must be accompanied by a qualified and physically able companion. Motorized scooters are unsuitable for touring

#### YOUNG TOUR PARTICIPANTS

Tour participants under 18 years must be accompanied by an adult. On escorted land tours we do not recommend children under the age of 8.

#### HEALTH REOUIREMENTS

Tour participants should check with the consulates and local health boards for the latest health requirements. No medical expenses will be covered for illnesses that occur prior to arrival or on the tour.

#### PETS

Due to safety reasons and comfort for all passengers, animals are not allowed in our tours and cruises.

#### SAFETY

Please be aware that during your participation in tours operated by Kompas, certain risks and dangers may arise beyond our control including, but not limited to, the hazards of traveling in undeveloped areas; travel by boat, train, automobile, aircraft or other means of transportation; the forces of nature, political unrest and accident or illness in remote regions without means of rapid evacuation or medical facilities. Kompas will not have liability regarding provision of medical care or the adequacy of any care that may be rendered. It is understood that Kompas will use its best efforts to ensure that adequate measures are taken. **RESPONSIBILITY \*\*\* IMPORTANT** 

#### Kompas and/or its agents act only in the capacity of agent for the passengers in all matters

pertaining to the tour, whether by plane, rail, motor coach, ferry, cruise boat or any other means of conveyance. They shall not be liable for any injury, damage or loss caused by neglect or default of any company or person engaged in conveying the tour, or any hotel proprietor or other person supplying services or material in connection with the tour.

#### **RESERVATION CHANGES-CRUISES**

In case of Adriatic Cruise product (incl. Land & Cruise products), it is possible to change the reservation and do the name change until 30 days before departure at 30 EUR fee per passenger. Extra costs will be applied in case of a different date/ cruise /cabin type. Within 30 days before departure standard cancellation fees will be applied.

#### FORCE MAJEURE

In case of any unforeseen circumstances during your cruise, including but not limited to: weather conditions, low or high waters, lock schedules, acts of God, government actions, political turmoil, disease, strikes, terrorism, general break down of equipment, closures or black outs of certain attractions listed in the program or similar, Kompas reserves the absolute right to change and/or alter any specific sailing date, itineray or a series of departure dates including implementing any of the following; a) substituting vessels of same or similar quality, b) operating portions of the sailing program via motor coach/hotel accommodations to replace boat schedules, c) substituting listed attractions with those of same or similar quality without prior notice. The vessel operators also reserve the right to cancel any particular sailing date or series of departures, for reasons outlined above, lack of participation or for any other reasons beyond their control. In the unlikely event of a cancelled sailing date, in conjunction with the vessel owners/operators, we reserve the right to offer an alternate date. If that tour is unacceptable, Kompas will refund all funds paid to Kompas: there is no additional liability.

#### SHIPS

Passengers on board are obliged to abide to the ship rules, as captain is responsible for the safety of all passengers and the crew. Jumping and diving from the boat during navigation, as well as climbing on the masts, is strictly forbidden. Swimming far from the boat or the coast should be avoided.
