Day by Day Itinerary

- Day 1 On arrival in Athens Transfer to your hotel. The balance of the day is free. Meet your fellow travelers tonight at a Welcome Taverna dinner in the Plaka beside the Acropolis. (D)
- Day 2 See the highlights of Athens, graceful temples, centuries-old monasteries and Byzantyne churches. This cosmopolitan and bustling capital city is set amid reminders of a long and glorious past. Visit the Acropolis, the Parthenon, the Erectheion with the Porch of the Maidens, the Temple of Athena Nike and other historic sites. Below the Acropolis lies the ancient Agora and the Theaters of Dionysus and Herodus Atticus.
 The afternoon and evening are at leisure. (B)
- Day 3 Your first stop this morning is **Delphi**, where the famous **Oracle** once foretold the destiny of men. The Temple of Apollo in which the Oracle functioned was built in the 6th century B.C. Also see the Sacred Way, The Stadium and the Castilian Fountain, where pilgrims cleansed themselves in preparation for consulting the Oracle. Visit the **Archeological Museum of Delphi** which contains an impressive collection of artifacts from the site, including the beautiful **"Bronze Charioteer"**.
 - Continue to Kalabaka for overnight an dinner. (B,D)
- Day 4 After breakfast admire the fantastic landscapes of Meteora, known as "the rocks that fell from the sky", where monks built their rock-top monasteries far away from civilization. Out of the 13 large and 20 small monasteries and hermit's cells only four are now active. The most important is Megalo of Great Meteoro with its tall and inticate dome, twelve sides and fine frescoes.
 - Continue across the border to North Macedonia and on to Ohrid. (B,D)
- Day 5 The lakeside resort of Ohrid is an important cultural and spiritual center, classified as UNESCO World Heritage site. Start Morning sightseeing with a walk through cobblestone streets of old town. Visit the Cathedral of St. Sofia, containing some magnificent frescoes for the 10th century. In early afternoon travel to Tirana, capital of Albania. (B,D)
- Day 6 On this morning sightseeing tour, see Sheshi Skenderbej (Skanderbeg Square), the Mosque of Ethem Bey, the Clock Tower and the statue of G.K.Skanderbeg, Albania's national hero; the Palace of culture and the National History Museum with a mosaic on its facade portraying Albanian history. The afternoon is free to continue exploring on your own, shop or simply relax. (B)
- Day 7 After breakfast leave Tirana towards the town of Shkodra, nowadays a major cultural center. Shkodra was the center of Illyrian tribe Labeat and was taken by the Romans in the year 168 B.C..You will have view of the Rozafa Castle, magnificently situated on a rocky outcrop of limestone high above the city, before we cross the border to Montenegro and drive via Bar and Budva to Tivat. Dinner upon arrival. (B,D)
- Day 8 After breakfast, your journey takes you to Dubrovnik. On the way, you will see Kotor Bay, the only South European fjord and stop for orientation tour of old town Kotor, an UNESCO Heritage site. Continue to Dubrovnik. (B,D)
- Day 9 After breakfast, walking tour of Old Dubrovnik. Visit the Rector's Palace and see the Bell Tower Clock, Orlando's Column, Sponza Palace, the Dominican Monastery with its Pharmacy, one of the oldest in the world. The afternoon is at leisure. (B)
- Day 10 After breakfast transfer to the Dubrovnik airport for your flight home. Extra nights are available if you wish to extend your stay in Europe. (B)



Day 4, Tuesday, Vik to Jokulsarlon and Breiddalsvik

Today we are traveling to the East of the island. On the way we will see the magnificent Fjadrargljufur canyon, stop at the Skaftafell visitor center in the Vatnajokull National Park - the largest national park in Iceland and the second largest in Europe. Afternoon we will take boat ride to the Jokulsárlón Lagoon – where clear water is invaded by blue-white icebergs, detached from Vatnajökull glacier. We continue to fish port of Hofn, the capital of Southeast Iceland, and in the evening, we will arrive at the hotel in Eastfjords area. **(B,D)**

Day 5, Wednesday, Breiddalsvik to Akureyri

Departure to Myvatn, and if the weather permits, we will stop at the Krafla caldera with the Leirhnujukur volcano. Today we will see the unique landscape of the Hverir geothermal area, the place where you will feel connected to the power of the planet with a red-orange landscape like on Mars! On the way we stop at Dimmuborgir lava formations, Namaskard thermal spring, Skutustadagigar pseudocraters, Godafoss waterfall, Hverfell mountain. **(B) Day 6, Thursday, Akureyri to Reykholt**

After breakfast we depart to Dalvik/Hjaltery for the Whale Watching. 

Day 1, Sunday, arrival in Oslo Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel. The balance of the day is free. Meet your fellow travelers tonight at Welcome reception. Overnight.(WR)

Day 2, Monday. Oslo to Lillehammer

This morning we begin our tour of the Norwegian capital, passing through the central area with the Cathedral, Parliament, main street Karl Johan, **University and Royal Palace with a** walk in the impressive **Vigeland park** with its more than two hundred incredible sculptures. Afterwards, drive to **Lillehammer**, site of the Winter Olympic Games in 1994. The clean air, varied landscapes, cultural events, museums with different themes such as the Art Museum, the Automobile Museum, and the Olympic Museum, make Lillehammer a city of culture, exhibitions, and festivals. Explore the old center with its wooden houses dating back to the 19th century and the main pedestrian street, Storgata. **(B, D)**

Day 3, Tuesday, Lillehammer, Molde/Kristiansund

Breakfast at hotel. Today drive through **Peer Gynt Road** with a stop for walking to see different views for this wonderful national park. Then continue via Romsdal Valley part of the Golden Route then, highly appreciated by climbing enthusiasts. We cross by **ferry** from Solnes to Afarnes and quick stop in Kristiansund. We continue the tour as we admire the fantastic piece of engineering which is "The Atlantic Road" from Kårvåg to Vevang, stopping Bud, before arriving the hotel. **(B)**

Day 4, Wednesday, Molde/Kristiansund, Nordfjord

After breakfast, we board a ferry to Vestnes and enjoy the scenic ride; winding along the narrow slopes of the mountain, bordered by stone railings, the **Trollstigen** -Trolls Road opened in 1936. The journey continues through the alpine landscape with **glacial lakes**, and **glaciers**. We will cross the Norddalsfjord from Linge to Eidsdal, after which we follow the Eagle's Road, an incredible winding sequence that will give us spectacular views of the **Geirangerfjord**, often described as the most beautiful fjord in all of Norway. We continue to the **Nordfjord** for dinner and overnight. **(B, D)**

Day 5, Thursday, Nordfjord to Bergen

Today our journey will take us to the **Fjærland** area where we admire the most spectacular the Jostedalsbreen glacier, namely the Boyabreen by Fjærland. We continue towards the longest and deepest fjord in Norway, the second largest in the world, **Sognefjord**, the King's Fjord. We'll cross this majestic stretch of water from Mannheller to Fodness, from where we'll head to Flam, passing through the **Lærdal Tunnel**, one of the longest tunnels in the world at 15 miles long. Arriving in **Bergen**, one of the most beautiful port cities in Norway. **(B)**

Day 6, Friday, Bergen

The morning tour the city of Bergen, traveling back in time through the narrow, dark, and mysterious streets of Bryggen, the former **Hanseatic historic harbor district**. We will visit the Fish Market with its lively picturesque atmosphere, one of the most visited open-air markets in Norway. Afternoon at leisure, time for individual sightseeing and shopping. **(B)**

Day 7, Saturday, Bergen via Hardangerfjord to Oslo

We head today to Sognefjord, the "king" of western Norway's fjords and Hardangerfjord is the "queen". Hardangervidda is Norway's largest national park known for its incredibly beautiful landscapes, but also for its herds of wild reindeer. **Early evening arrival in Oslo. (B)**

Day by Day Itinerary

- Day 1: Upon arrival in Warsaw, transfer to the hotel. Meet your tour guide and fellow travelers at 6pm in the lobby. Drive along the Royal Route with its historical monuments and residences. Stop at Castle Square for a short walk through Old Town, then join us for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Warsaw. (D)
- After breakfast, a half day guided city tour shows you the major sights of Warsaw. In the evening, Chopin recital with a glass of sparkling wine. Overnight in Warsaw. (B,L)
 After breakfast, departure to Zakopane. Drive to Czestochowa to visit the Jasna Gora Monastery to see the Black Madonna Shrine and treasury. Jasna Gora is a religious and
 - spiritual center. Lunch at a local restaurant. In the evening, **we arrive in Zakopane**, beautifully situated at the foot of the Tatra Mountains. At the beginning of the 20th century, it became the favorite place of artists and musicians. Overnight in Zakopane. **(B,L)**
- Pay 4: Buffet breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, sightseeing in Zakopane. You will visit the Jaszczurowka Chapel, great example of the local wooden architecture Take the cable car to the top of Gubalowka Mountain to admire the view. In the afternoon, rafting trip on the Dunajee river in Pieniny National Park. Continue to Krakow for dinner at a local restaurant in Krakow's Old Town Market Square. Overnight in Krakow. (B,L)
- Day 5: After breakfast a **guided city tour of Krakow**. The former royal city on the Vystula river is situated at the foot of the Wawel Hill. Later, drive to Old Town and visit the main Market Square and Cloth Hall, built before 1349. After lunch, **we drive to Auschwitz-Birkenau** for a memorial tour of the former Nazi Concentration Camp. The

camp was set up in 1940 for prisoners from Poland, but from 1941 on, the Nazis imprisoned people there from all countries occupied by the Third Reich. You will see an exhibition entitled "Man Did This To Man" in the huts once used to house inmates. Overnight in Krakow. **(B,L)**

Day 6: After breakfast, free time to explore Krakow on your own. In the afternoon, visit the Wieliczka Salt Mine to see the unique underground world of salt lakes, galleries and chapels. Admire the statues carved in salt by many generations of Polish miners. You will also see up to 20 excavated chambers on 3 levels and the Salt Works Museum. Dinner with folklore show at a local restaurant in Wieliczka. Overnight in Krakow. (B,D)
Day 7: After breakfast end of your escorted tour. Transfer to the airport. (B)

Day by Day Itinerary

At 6:00pm, meet your guide and the rest of the group in the hotel lobby. Drive along the ay 1: renovated **Royal Route** with its historical monuments and residences. Stop at Castle Square for a short walk through Old Town, and then join us for welcome dinner. (D) This morning, we introduce you to the **highlights of Warsaw**. Day 8: In the morning, we see the highlights of Torun. Its Old Town has been included in UNESCO's list for its 13th century Town Hall, superb churches and historic streets, pre serving Torun's past glory. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant in Torun. This afternoon, we drive to Gdansk. There, we take a brief walk through the town's Old Town.(B,L)

Day 9: Today, we tour Gdansk in depth. We continue to Malbork for lunch and visit the Teuton ic Knights Castle. After coming back Gdansk the balance of the day is free. (B,L)

Day 10: After breakfast we drive to Gdynia. We will also visit Oliwa Cathedral famous for one-of-a-kind pipe organ. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant. In the afternoon we drive for Warsaw, where you will have a farewell dinner.(B,L)
